WEIGHTED CREDIT/RANK-IN-CLASS

Certain courses have been determined to be much more demanding academically than most high school level courses. For the purpose of college application, a weighted rank-in-class system is used. All credit-bearing courses are included in the computation. All classes use the following scale: A=4.0, A-=3.7, B+=3.3, B=3.0, B-=2.7, C+=2.3, C=2.0, C-=1.7, D+=1.3, D=1.0, and E=0. At the successful completion of each accelerated or honors class, an additional .025 per credit is added. Likewise, .05 is added for each credit after successful completion of each Advanced Placement course.

These courses are available for students who are above average learners and wish to pursue more difficult studies. AP courses cover college-level course content.
