Grading Information

Credit is awarded for academic classes on a per-semester basis. The GPA is calculated based on this 4.00 scale: A = 4.00, A- = 3.67, B+ = 3.33, B = 3.00, B- = 2.67, C+ = 2.33, C = 2.00, C- = 1.67, D+ = 1.33, D = 1.00, D- = 0.67, F = 0.00. In the weighted GPA, grade points are weighted by one point in Advanced Placement (AP), Advanced Studies (AS), and Honors courses. The cumulative GPA calculation only includes Sonoma Academy courses from 10th, 11th and 12th grades.

In Sonoma Academy's mixed block schedule, students take a combination of full year and semester long courses. The semester courses meet for two periods during the day, giving them equivalent class time to yearlong courses. Students are required to be on an athletic team or take a PE class during every term of enrollment in 9th and 10th grade, and earn a full year's PE credit in each of those years. Sonoma Academy does not rank its students.
